**CREATIVE CAREERS**: Partnering with Creative Oklahoma, Oklahoma Film + Music & Junior Achievement, I created a multi-platform career resource to drive labor into career paths in the Arts & Culture sector. Our pilot program in January, 2021, involving more than 20 film professionals, reached over 30,000 students. We are currently developing the project to cover more paths.

**CREATIVE CATALYST**: I am a facilitator for an innovative certificate program that complements artistic practice with 21st century skills-building to transform the ways artists approach creative challenges and translate their artistic skills to work in other fields. **THE O. GAIL POOLE COLLECTION**: I am the owner and curator of an enormous collection of original art by my late father. I promote Poole's legacy through advocacy, philanthropy, publications, lectures and exhibitions including solo shows at the Fred Jones, Jr. Museum of Art, Oklahoma Hall of Fame, Artspace at Untitled, Casa dell'Energia (Arezzo) and Galerie Arludik (Paris). Its subsequent iteration in Bricktown employed 10 performing artists, reaching 500 people. 2020-2021.

**SOUNDPAINTING** is the universal sign language for real-time composition created by composer Walter Thompson. I have worked closely with Thompson since 1997 and am a certified Soundpainting composer, performer and instructor (Multidisciplinary II). I have performed widely in NYC and throughout Europe, collaborating with composers and performers from over 35 countries. 1997 – Present

**KOLLECTI'F** is an international, multi-disciplinary collective of five women from 4 countries collaborating in provocative theatrical interventions; our inaugural "Cabaret Poetique" debuted in the Geneva, Switzerland school system during Human Rights Week in January, 2020. 2020-Present.

**NARRATOR**: I have narrated over 200 titles for the industry's major publishers and independent authors. My work has been recognized by *AudioFile, Publisher's Weekly,* the Association of Libraries and as a twotime finalist for the *Audie* Awards. (2007-Present)

Nicole Poole is a Multidisciplinary Artist and Culture Activist specializing in creative strategies and contemporary collaboration.

Nicole's synthesis of classical training and avant-garde forms has led to a vast range of experience, from the NY International Fringe Festival and the Tony Award-winning New Group (NYC) to the Royal Shakespeare Company (London), the SoundPainting Orchestra de l'Union des Musiciens de Jazz (Paris), and many fascinating points in between. She has worked with the late John Barton and Sir Peter Hall (*Tantalus*), contemporary composer Anthony Braxton (WTO/Irondale), Chevalier des Arts et Lettres François Jeanneau (*Parisian Jazz Chronicles*/SPOUMJ).

A core member of the Walter Thompson Orchestra, Nicole has worked directly with Thompson to develop Soundpainting, the universal sign language for live composition, since 1997. She is one of only a handful of theatre artists worldwide certified in its use and performs and teaches extensively, from Belgium to Vassar. She recently joined forces with artists from England, France, Spain, Switzerland to form Kollecti'F, an international poetic cabaret performing in Geneva, Switzerland, during Human Rights Week, slated to return in 2022.

An accomplished national voice talent, Nicole's audiobook narration has been recognized through awards from *AudioFile, Publisher's Weekly,* the Association of Libraries and as a two-time finalist for the *Audie* Awards. She is a member of AEA, SAG-AFTRA and the UMJ (Paris).

Her managerial experience includes NYC's SoHo Rep (Managing Director), Ensemble Studio Theatre (Marketing Director), Strike Anywhere Performance Ensemble and Monkey Wrench Theatre (Fundraising) and OKC Repertory Theatre (Board Secretary/Grantwriter). She is also the owner and curator of The O. Gail Poole Collection, a vast collection of artwork by her late father. She has produced eponymous exhibits in Oklahoma (Fred Jones, Jr. Museum of Art; Oklahoma Hall of Fame), Paris (Galerie Arludik) and Arezzo (Casa dell'Energia).

Nicole spearheads dynamic initiatives for cultural advocacy, most recently with arts in education initiative <u>Creative Careers</u>, and a series of site-specific performances tailored for a pandemic, <u>You Are Here</u>. She is also a facilitator for the University of North Carolina School of the Arts' <u>Creative Catalyst</u> program, guiding artists through training in leadership, innovation and entrepreneurship. She is the founding recipient of the Paseo Arts Association's 2020 Inspirational Influencer Award.
